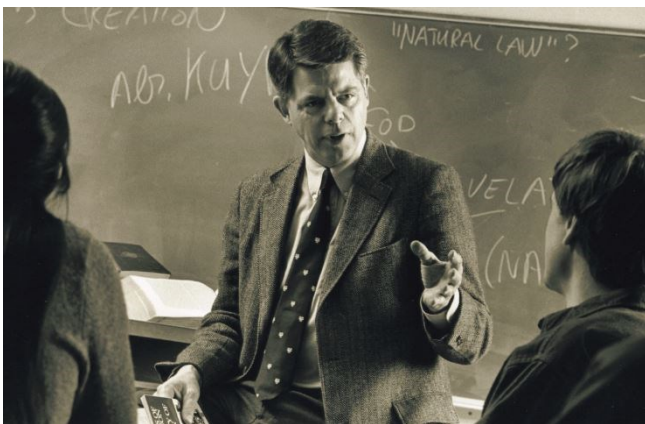

The Th.M. program is designed to increase the students knowledge of a major field of theological learning, furthering preparation for ministry, or more advanced graduate study. The Modular component allows students to complete the necessary course work by enrolling in week long classes offered three times a year. Included in the total cost is housing, local transportation (not including an airline ticket to or from Philadelphia), and food which is provided by Westminster.
