### Directions

#### From the Pennsylvania Turnpike:

Exit at the Fort Washington Interchange (#339). Exit right onto Rt. 309 South (immediately after passing under the turnpike overpass). Take the first exit - PA 73/Flourtown (about 1.2 miles). Turn left onto Church Road (PA 73 East) and go about 1.7 miles. After passing through the third traffic light (crossing Willow Grove Avenue) the Seminary entrance will be on your right at the top of the hill. **From the South Via I-95:** Take Rt. 476 North to the PA Turnpike (about 20 miles) and proceed East. Derek Thomas is the John E. Richards Professor of Systematic and Practical Theology at Reformed Theological Seminary, Jackson, Mississippi. Originally from Wales, he spent seventeen years pastoring in Belfast before moving to the United States in 1996. In addition to his work at RTS, he serves as the Minister

of Teaching at First Presbyterian Church in Jackson. A graduate of RTS in 1978, he gained a Ph.D. from the University of Wales, Lampeter in Calvin's preaching on the book of Job. He has written and edited numerous books, including *The Storm Breaks: Job Simply Explained, Wisdom: the Key to Living God's Way* and *God Strengthens: Ezekiel Simply Explained*. His most recent publication is a joint venture with his wife, *A Biblical Guide to Love, Sex and Marriage.* He and his wife, Rosemary have been married for over thirty years and have two adult children and two grandchildren.



**Carl R. Trueman** (M.A., St. Catharine's College, Cambridge; Ph.D., University of Aberdeen;) is Vice President for Academic Affairs and Professor of Historical Theology and Church History at Westminster Theological Seminary. He also is a monthly columnist for Reformation21.com and regular columnist for the

monthly publication of the Free Church of Scotland. He has authored numerous books, including, *The Claims of Truth: John Owen's Trinitarian Theology, The Wages of Spin: Critical Writings on Historic and Contemporary Evangelicalism* and *Minority Report: Unpopular Essays on Everything from Ancient Christianity to Zen Calvinism.* He is also an ordained minister in the Orthodox Presbyterian Church.



William Edgar (M.Div., Westminster Theological Seminary; Dr. Théol., Université de Genève) is Professor of Apologetics at Westminster Theological Seminary, coordinator of the Apologetics Department and Chairman of the Faculty. He has authored several books, including *Reasons of the Heart: Recovering Christian* 

*Persuasion, Taking Note of Music* and *In Spirit and In Truth*. He is also an ordained minister in the Presbyterian Church in America.



Timothy Z. Witmer (M.Div., Westminster Theological Seminary; D.Min., Reformed Theological Seminary;) is the coordinator of the Practical Theology Department, Professor of Practical Theology, and Director of Mentored Ministry at Westminster Theological Seminary. In addition, he is the Minister of

Preaching at Crossroads Community Church in Upper Darby, Pennsylvania.
